*We anticipate placing a luminary every 36 inches, on both sides of your driveways and a single row on sidewalks along your property. A load of sand will be placed in the pool parking lot for homeowners to use in their bags. Candles will be provided with the bags and will burn for 4 hrs. Anticipate lighting them at or around 6 p.m. on Christmas Eve. **The cost this year will be covered by a Greg Newman/ Homestead Real Estate!!***

Longer driveways with shorter fronts take 40

Normal driveway and fronts take 25-35

If this time doesn't work for you, please call Becky or Pam and we will make alternate plans for your pick up.

Sand will be placed in the pool parking lot—just grab a bucket or wagon and take what you will need to place approx. 1 inch of sand in each bag.
