**Dinner Club themes:**

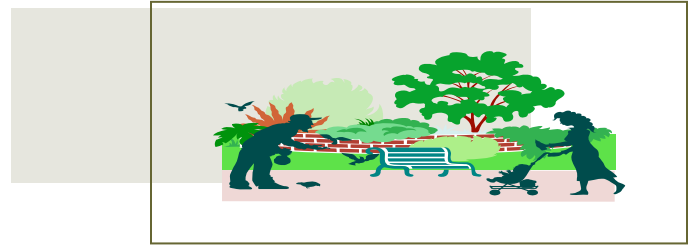


**May 18th, 2008** - Brunch
